

# The Plitvice lakes

- ▣ Group of 16 lakes connected by the waterfalls created by deposition of travertine
- ▣ On the UNESCO World Heritage list
- ▣ Beside the lakes, the landscape is adorned by the diversity of flora and fauna



# The Brijuni isles



- ▣ 2 large and 12 smaller isles
- ▣ Ruins of the Roman Empire
- ▣ Beautiful, untouched nature
- ▣ On the UNESCO World Heritage list are not only the isles, but the sea surrounding the Brijuni
- ▣ Favourite summer vacation destination for the Croatian government

# The Kornati isles

- ▣ The most indented island group in the Mediterranean Sea - a group of 140 + islands
- ▣ Bizzare shapes and naturally big cliffs point out these isles
- ▣ Nearby there is a nature park Telašćica also singled out as a protected part of nature



# Kopački rit

- ▣ One of the most important and largest wetlands in Europe
- ▣ Part was separated under strict protection as a special zoological reserve
- ▣ Concern about the environment has resulted in a completely unharmed wetland area

# The Pula amphitheater

- ▣ World's biggest tie was tied around the amphitheater itself


# Palace of Diocletian

# Fortress Brod

- ▣ Baroque fort which served as the first line of defense against the onslaught of the Ottomans
- ▣ Centralized composition
- ▣ Well-fortified
- ▣ Today- home to many cultural institutions



# Dubrovnik

# Znamenitosti


Od prirodnih znamenitosti svojom ljepotom se ističu:

# Plitvička jezera

- ▣ 16 jezera povezanih sedrenim barijerama
- ▣ Nalazi se na UNESCO-vom popisu svjetske baštine
- ▣ Osim jezera, krajolik krasi obilje i raznovrsnost flore i faune.



# Brijuni


- ▣ 2 velika i 12 malih otoka, poznatih po ostacima Rimskog Carstva i flori i fauni.
- ▣ Pod UNESCO-voim zaštitoim nisu samo otoci već i more koje ih okružuje
- ▣ Omiljeno ljetovalište poznatih državnika.

# Kornati

- ▣ Najrazvedenija otočna skupina Sredozemnog mora - skupina od 140+ otoka
- ▣ Ističu se bizarnim prirodnim oblicima i velikim klifovima
- ▣ U neposrednoj blizini nalazi se i Park prirode Telaščica, također izdvojen kao zaštićeni dio prirode

# Kopački rit

- ▣ Jedan od najvažnijih i najvećih močvarnih područja Europe
- ▣ Dio je izdvojen pod strogu zaštitu kao specijalni zoološki rezervat
- ▣ Briga o okolišu je rezultirala potpuno netaknutošću močvarnog prostora

# Pulski amfiteatar

- ▣ Antički spomenik sagrađen za vladavine Flavijevaca
- ▣ U njoj su se odvijale gladijatorske i viteške borbe
- ▣ Više puta obnavljana i restaurirana



# Dioklecijanova palača

- ▣ Centralizirana kompozicija
- ▣ Dobro utvrđena
- ▣ Danas dom mnogim kulturološkim ustanovama



# Dubrovnik

- ▣ Jedan od najpoznatijih sredozemnih gradova
- ▣ Središte mnogih kulturoloških zbivanja
- ▣ Ljetno odredište mnogih Hollywoodskih zvijezda
- ▣ Na UNESCO-voj listi svjetske baštine.

# Zagrebačka katedrala

- ▣ Središte Zagrebačke biskupije
- ▣ Najpoznatija hrvatska katedrala
- ▣ Mnogo puta oštećivana kroz povijest, ali uz današnju tehnologiju joj se vraća stari izgled
