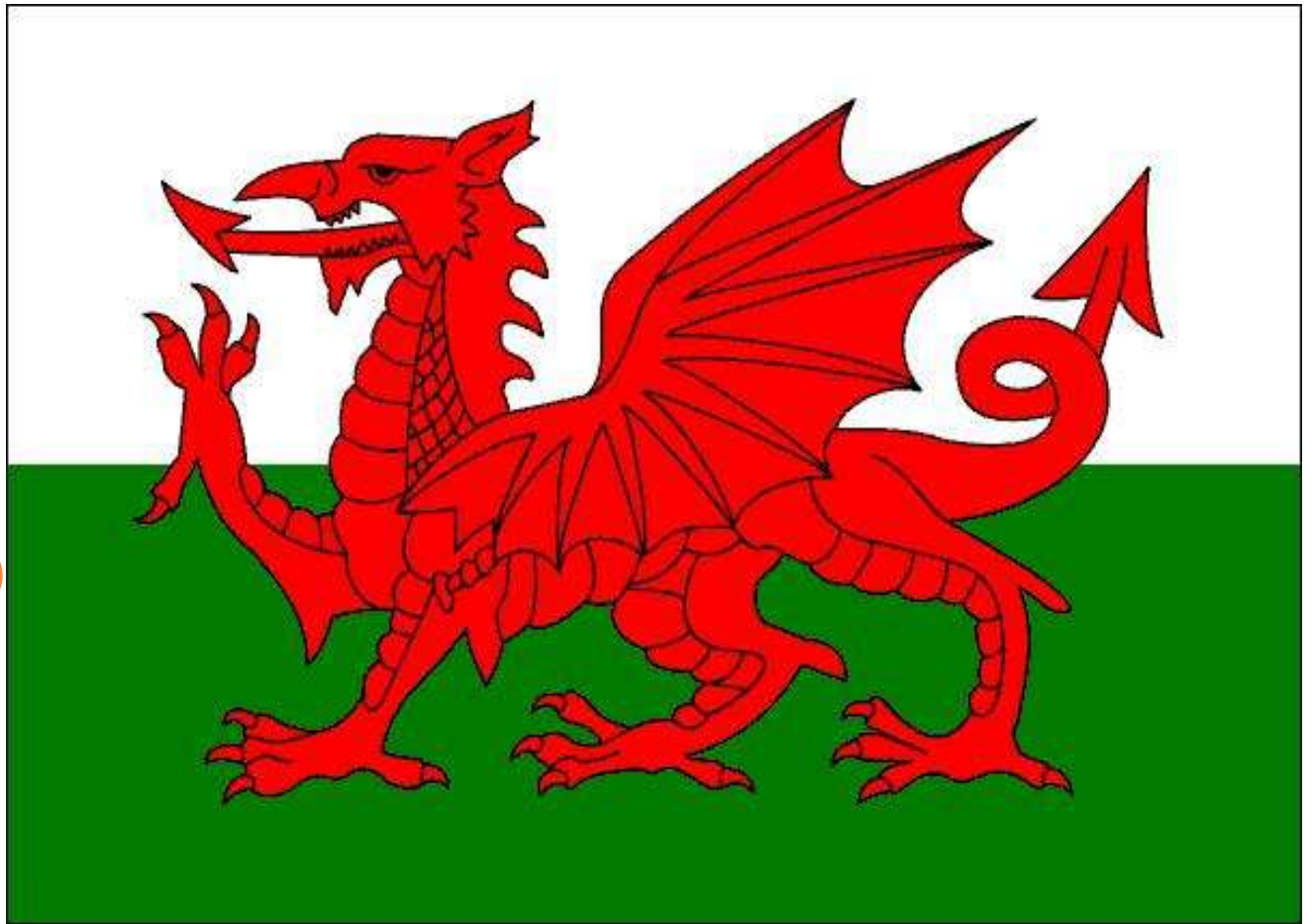


# WALES

- The area of Wales is 20 760 km<sup>2</sup>.



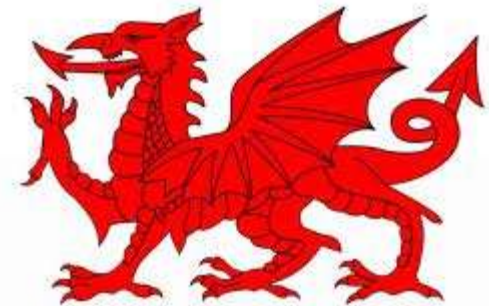
# POPULATION

- Welsh traditional food are leek soup and Welsh tea cakes.

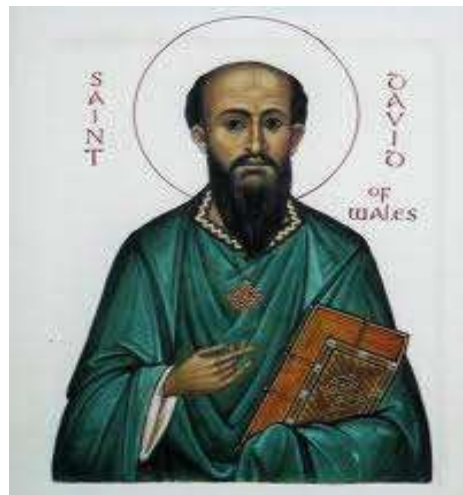
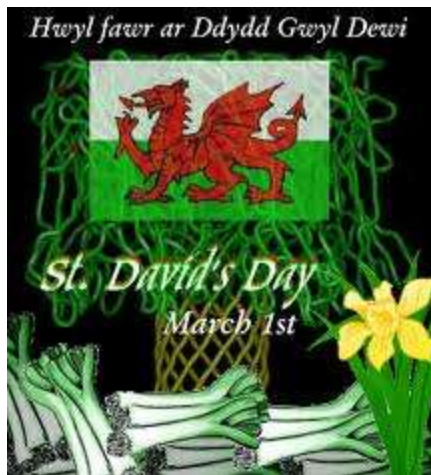


- This is Welsh national costume:
